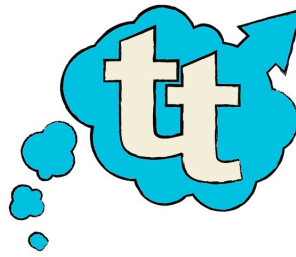

Attendance averages around 1,000 with over 100 students who actually participate by performing in Airband itself.
