### **TomTod Ideas and the Canton Symphony Orchestra present "Landfill Harmonic"**

Canton, OH – Oct. 18, 2016 – TomTod Ideas and the Canton Symphony Orchestra will present the award-winning documentary "Landfill Harmonic" on Nov. 17 at 7 p.m. at the Canton Palace Theatre. Tickets are \$5. Doors open at 6:30 p.m. and proceeds will benefit TomTod Ideas and the Canton Symphony.

"Landfill Harmonic" follows a group of Paraguayan children and teens that form the Recycled Orchestra of Cateura, a musical group playing instruments made completely out of trash. Favio Chávez, an environmental engineer with a musical background, directs the orchestra. He and his friend, Nicolas, build instruments for the children out of scavenged junk from the landfill.

"The Canton Symphony always strives to foster a love of live classical music," Michelle Mullaly, President and CEO of the Canton Symphony Orchestra, said. "'Landfill Harmonic' demonstrates what a gift music truly is – to hear and perform!"

When a natural disaster strikes their hometown of Cateura, Chávez and the students must find hope and healing with the music they create.
